Children's Discovery Museum of San Jose has expanded its innovative, field-based science program, known as BioSITE (Students Investigating Their Environment), to include an afterschool program and we need you to help make it happen! Come be a part of this EXCITING, and FUN program AND earn all of your required community services hours while you're at it!

### Who?

High school sophomore, junior, and senior students will lead 4th and 5th grade students in fun, hands-on river investigating activities. No experience is necessary. You will receive special training from the Museum which will prepare you to teach simple science lessons and to work with younger children during this after school program.

### What?

You will join the program as part of a group of "Science Mentors" for younger kids and receive hands-on science training. BioSITE ACE teaches students a series of fun, river-related science activities, including water quality testing, insect investigating, and watershed mapping, at the Museum's Guadalupe River field site!

### When?

You and a team of high school students from throughout the area, will meet after school two days a week; every Monday, and either Tuesdays or Wednesdays, depending on your schedule. We ask that you commit at least one semester of the school year. By joining BioSITE ACE, you will fulfill your required community service hours!

### Where?

At Children's Discovery Museum of San Jose - outdoors, at the river site, in the Museum's 11-acre Guadalupe River Park location.
