If you feel sensitivity to noise may be an issue, headphones or similar solutions are recommended; a few loaners will be available upon request at the Museum.

Feel free to bring your own food and drink if your child has special dietary needs. Eating is permitted in the *Cafe* only.

Strollers are welcome in most areas of the Museum; stroller parking areas are designated where necessary. These areas are unsupervised.

No animals other than service animals are permitted.

Alcohol is not permitted in the Museum during this event.

Cameras are welcome. Please be sensitive to children who may be bothered by the flash.

Who should attend?

We encourage the whole family to join us, as Museum activities will appeal to the whole family. This event is limited to 400 guests.

Museum Entry

The Museum borders Woz Way, but the actual entrance faces Discovery Meadow and San Carlos Street. Check-in will be located inside the entrance.

What to expect

The Museum is self-guided and hands-on. Please note that an adult must remain with your child at all times.

Schedule

Doors open 5:30 p.m.

A vendor and resource area will be located in the "Streets" near the Museum entry throughout the evening.

Amenities

The *Cafe* will **not** be open during the event. You are also welcome to bring food; seating will be available.

A Museum map has been designed to assist you in navigating the Museum.

The Museum is wheelchair accessible.

Staff will be available to assist with Visitor Service, security, and First Aid. Staff can be identified by their purple shirts and name tags. Volunteers will be wearing "Volunteer" name tags.

Men's, women's and family restrooms are located on the first floor. Men's and women's are on the second floor.

The Museum has one elevator.

A limited number of coin-operated lockers are available for personal storage.

Hand sanitizer dispensers are located in the lobby and in the Wonder Cabinet on the second floor.

This event will generally have a special feature, please check out the website close to the event for details.

Directions and Parking

Directions from major freeways:

Heading North on I-280

Exit on Bird Ave.

Turn right on Bird Ave.

Turn right on Auzerais Ave. (parking lot on the right)

Turn right on Woz Way (parking lot on the right)

Heading South on I-280

Exit on Bird Ave.

Turn left on Bird Ave.

Turn right on Auzerais Ave. (parking lot on the right)

Turn right on Woz Way (parking lot on the right)

Heading North on 87 (Guadalupe Parkway)

Exit at San Carlos/Auzerais.

Turn right on Woz Way (parking lot on the right) OR

Turn left on Woz Way and left on Auzerais (parking lot on the left)


Heading South on 87 (Guadalupe Parkway)

Exit on Park Ave./San Carlos St.

Turn left on Park Ave.

Turn right on Woz Way (parking lot on the right) OR

Turn right on Auzerais (parking lot on the left)

Parking

Parking is available this evening in the parking lots on Woz Way and around the Museum at parking meters. The Museum does not reimburse for parking fees.

The Woz Way parking lot is \$7.00 per day. The machines take cash or Visa and MasterCard.

The Auzerais lot is also \$7.00 per day, and has a parking attendant.

Parking fees are subject to change when there are large events in downtown. The Museum does not control parking lots or the rates charged.

Metered parking on Woz Way is free after 6:00 p.m.

Handicapped parking is available in the Museum's loading zone, adjacent to Woz Way.

Public Transportation
