**Bill's Backyard: Bridge to Nature** is Children's Discovery Museum's new 27,500 sq ft garden and nature play space, designed to encourage children and their caregivers to experience the creativity, curiosity, fun, and magic of outdoor play in the middle of an urban environment. Including a tree climbing area, fort building, gravel dig pit, junior ranger station, and vegetable garden, this fun and interactive area will encourage children and their caregivers to explore the natural world, inspiring the next generation of environmental stewards.

The **Garden Ecology Program Developer** will have overall responsibility for *Bill's Backyard: Bridge to Nature* by developing innovative environmental programs and activities, training and coaching part-time nature play facilitators and youth volunteers, aligning Bill's Backyard opportunities with Museum-wide initiatives, managing program materials, and developing community partnerships. With support for regular maintenance, the Garden Ecology Program Developer will help oversee planting, pruning, and general health of the outdoor nature space, and will be responsible for seasonal planting, maintenance, and harvesting of the vegetable garden.
